

# Information clause concerning personal data

## Attachment 1

1. The Pilecki Institute (the Institute of Solidarity and Valor with its seat in Warsaw, ul. Foksal 17, 00-372 Warsaw) is the data controller of the personal data of the participants and the winner.
  2. All personal data will be processed in compliance with the regulations provided for in the Regulation (EU) No 2016/679 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 27 April 2016 on the protection of natural persons with regard to the processing of personal data and on the free movement of such data, and repealing Directive 95/46/EC.
  3. The Personal Data Protection Inspector can be contacted in all cases concerning personal data at [iodo@isim.waw.pl](mailto:iodo@isim.waw.pl)
  4. The personal data of candidates and participants will be processed for the purposes of the application process, for tax purposes in the case of tax obligations, and for marketing purposes.
  5. Submitting personal data is voluntary, but necessary to apply for the project.
  6. The candidates who submitted their personal data have the right access their personal data and, subject to the relevant law, to amend or delete their data and restrict its processing or transferring, as well as to object to its use and withdraw consent at any time.
  7. The organizer will collect the following data from the candidates and the participants: name and surname, email address, telephone number and a short bio.
  8. Moreover, the organizer will collect the following data from the participants: correspondence address, tax identification number (NIP or PESEL), date of birth, name and address of the Tax Office, bank account number (to cover travel expenses).

1. In all cases regarding the processing of personal data, the participants in the school have the right to file a charge with the competent supervisory authorities.
  2. Participants in the school grant consent for their name and surname to be used in information about the results (including in the media).
  3. The organizer declares that the personal data of the participants will not be subject to automated processing or profiling.
  4. The personal data of the participants shall not be disclosed to any third parties except as

provided in relevant law.

5. The personal data of the participants will be stored for the period necessary for achieving the above-specified aims.

6. The organizer implemented appropriate technical and organizational measures for ensuring the security of the personal data, which are adequate to the risks and the category of protected data. The organizer implemented appropriate measures to ensure a level of security appropriate to the risk, taking account of available technology and the cost of implementation, the nature, scope, context and purposes of the processing, as well as the risks of varying likelihood and severity for rights and freedoms of natural persons posed by the processing. The organizer takes account particularly of the following risks presented by processing: accidental or unlawful destruction, loss, alteration, unauthorized disclosure of or access to personal data transmitted, stored or otherwise processed.
